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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

Cumulative Revenue Performance by Source by end of quarter one, the receipts of the vote stood at Uganda Shillings: 4,410,859,000/=representing 29 percent of the annual approved budget. This was slightly higher than 25 percent of the expected revenue receipts for quarter one. This was higher due to COVID-19 supplementary budget of 286,400,000/=. One off receipts of Other Government Transfers of 100,000,000/= meant for completion of Four (4) Classroom Block in Obalanga Comprehensive Secondary School, Increased Local Revenue collected as compared to expected in the quarter and Development Grants due to the nature of their release (33%) in 3 quarters. In aggregate despite over performance (above the desired 25%), individually Locally Raised Revenues, Discretionary Government Transfers and Conditional Government Transfers performed slightly above; at 29%(46,100,000), 27% (574,051,000) and 30% (3,632,985,000) respectively while Other Government Transfers and External Financing performed at 19% and 12% respectively. In detail, the recurrent central government transfers performed at and above the expected of 25% with District Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage), Urban Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage), Urban Unconditional Grant (Wage), District Unconditional Grant (Wage), Pension and Gratuity all performed at 25% as expected while Sector Conditional Grant (Non-Wage) far much higher at 41 percent. Development Revenues (District DDEG, Urban DDEG, Transitional Development grant & Sector Development Grants) performed at 33% due to the nature of their release (3 times). Other Government Transfers performed at 19 percent while External Financing registered the lowest performance of 12 percent of the expected annual out turn. These small percentages in External financing and Other Government transfers were attributed to donors and other Government ministries not releasing the funds pledged as planned. Despite the aforementioned receipts to the tune of 4,410,859,000 (29%) the vote spent only 2,062,435,000 accounting for only 14% of the annual budget.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

The district collected Ugx: 46,100,000/=for this quarter. This indicates 29 percent revenue performance clearly stating that Other fines and Penalties from other government units and Land fees performed much better than all the other local revenue sources; at 155% and 72% respectively as compared to Market/Gate charges and Local Service Tax that performed at 53% and 20 % of the estimated annual provisions respectively. The overall poor performance in local revenue against planned is because of Covid-19 Pandemic that continues to affect our major weekly Markets after the closure of markets was pronounced.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

Overall, the vote received a total of Ugx: 4,207,036,000 as central government transfers representing 95 percent of revenue receipts. The disbursement is 30 percent, and is slightly higher than the expected percentage of 25%. This arose because of the high performance of Sector Conditional Grant Non-Wage(Health) due to COVID-19 supplementary budget.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

The vote received 135,129,000 as other government transfers representing 19 percent of estimated revenue receipts for quarter one. The disbursement is only 19 percent, which is below the expected 25 percent for the quarter. These funds were received from Uganda Road Fund and Northern Uganda Social Action Fund (NUSAF), Micro Projects under Luwero Rwenzori Development Programme and Uganda Women Entrepreneurship Program (UWEP), Other organizations that had shared IPFs with the district are yet to fulfill their obligations in the subsequent quarters.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

The vote received only 22,594,000 from GAVI. This was 12% of the projected annual budget of 185,000,000. The Aids Support Organization (TASO) is expected to remit their obligations in the second quarter of the financial year.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of quarter one, the Sub Sub Program had received total revenue share of 287,570,000/= representing 25% of the annual planned budget. The cumulative out turn of recurrent revenues was Uganda Shillings 241,959,000/= representing (27%) and Development of 45,611,000/= representing 9% as a result of prioritization of road works. On the other hand, the following recurrent revenue sources performed at 25% as desired; District Unconditional Grants performing at Ugx: 15,592,000/=, District Unconditional Grant-Wage at Ugx: 86,100,000/=, Gratuity for Local Governments at Ugx: 59,693,000/= and Pension for Local Governments at 22,804,000/=. Besides that, Locally Raised Revenues, Multi-sectoral transfers to LLG Non-wage and Urban Unconditional Grant (Wage) performed below and above the desired; at 22%, 29% and 40% respectively, the District Discretionary Equalization Grant (DDEG) performed below due to the prioritization of road works in Q1. The department spent Ugx: 225,103,000/= representing 20% of the annual budget which is broken down as wage expenditure that performed at 24% (103,725,000/=) slightly below the expected, followed by non-wage at Ugx: 111,466,000/=accounting for 23% and development at Ugx: 9,903,000/= (4%) of the annual budget. The Sub Sub Program had a total unspent balance of Ugx: 62,466,000/= representing 22% of the amount received in first Quarter of which total recurrent balance was 26,758,000/= representing 11% with Wage balance of Ugx: 15,832,000/= and Non-Wage balance of Ugx: 10,936,000/=, Development Balances (Domestic Development) amounted to Ugx: 35,708,000/= representing 78%.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The development amount of 35,708,000 was not expended, Most Development activities were carried forward to be implemented in Quarter 2 of the financial year. Low consumption by Lower Local Governments.

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Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By close of Quarter one, the Sub-Sub Programme had received 71,644,000 from both the recurrent and development sources. This represented 28%, of the expected annual out turn, which was slightly above the anticipated of 25% as at close of Quarter one for reasons that; Development funds are released three times a year contrary to the normal cycle of four times for all the other grants and more so, more funds were released to LLGs over and above the desired. Out of this, the recurrent component contributed 68,668,000 (28%) and Development of 2,977,000 representing 33% of the expected annual out turn. Apart from the District Unconditional Grant (Non-wage) and the District Unconditional Grant (Wage) that performed at 25% of the desired, Urban Unconditional Grant (wage), Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_Non Wage, and Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_Gou performed above the desired; at 28%,33%,33% respectively, while the locally raised revenues performed below at only 15% of the expected annual outturn. The Sub- Sub Programme spent 47,236,000 constituting 19% of the annual expected expenditure outcome. This expenditure is broken down in to: Wage of 26,594,000 representing 22% and Non-wage to the tune of 19,580,000 accounting for 16% of the annual estimated outcome. Development expenditure was 1,062,000 representing 12% of the annual estimate. The Sub-Sub Programme had an unspent balance of 24,409,000 representing 34% of the released budget. This was further broken down in to; Recurrent of 22,494,000(33%) constituting of a wage worth 4,535,000, non-wage of 17,959,000 and Domestic Development amounting to 1,915,000 (64%).

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The Sub-sub programme had an unspent balance of 24,409,000 and the reasons for the same were; Failure to absorb the wage component because of the staffing gaps still unfilled in Town Council. Delayed transfer of some funds to Sub-counties due to some technicalities beyond our reach. Low absorption of funds released to the Lower Local Governments (LLGs) in Quarter one.

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Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of the Quarter, the Sub-sub program had received UGX 97,661,000 as total revenue shares representing 26% of the annual budget. This was slightly higher than the anticipated out turn of 25% expected at close of the Quarter. Whereas all this is the performance of the Recurrent revenues, the Development Component was not allocated to the sub sub program and so its performance is at 0%. Out of the total recurrent revenues UCG (Non -Wage) performed at 50,784,000 representing 25% of the annual out turn, UCG (wage) performed at 32,093,000 representing 25% of the annual out turn both performing exactly as expected in a quarter. Locally Raised revenues contributed 10,000,000 accounting for 31% performing slightly higher than the expected annual out turn. Multi-sectoral Transfers to LLGs performed at 4,785,000 accounting for 28%. The Sub sub program total expenditure amounted to 57,465,000/= representing 15% of the annual outturn of which UCG (wage) of 18,362,000 accounting for 14% and UCG (Non-Wage) of 39,103,000 accounting for 16% of the total revenues received living the total unspent balance of 40,197,000 representing 41%.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balances of 43,147,000 arose as a result of non-enrollment of all Political Leader to the payroll that left 13,731,000 unspent under wage and the Commissions of council that had not been fictionalized in the first quarter as this was the time they had been instituted not approved by the Public service commission for the case of DSC, District Land Board and DPAC equally were not yet functional and contributed to unspent balances of 26,890,000 under non-wage.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

The Sub Sub Program was able to achieve payment of three month Wages to 9 Political leaders who had accessed government pay roll, Held one council meeting that passed relevant resolutions that put in place the Standing committees of Council, DSC, DPAC, District land Bord and approved supplementary budget on Covid -19 a among others. Paid three month Ex- Gratia for 22 District Council members, Paid for District Chairpersons and DEC members quarterly fuel at 3,350,000, made payments for the repair of the District chairpersons Vehicle at 2,000,000. Held three DEC meetings for the quarter with relevant resolution, Met administrative costs of Stationary, travels for the District Chairperson, welfare and small office equipment for the quarter were procured, Held evaluation and contracts committee meetings that secured service providers in different capacities for the district. Facilitated submission of the Land files to the Zonal office in Soroti.

The over performance is attributed to receipt of Ugx: 100,000,000 from other government transfers meant for completion of construction works in Obalanga Comprehensive SS and also Multi Sectoral Transfers _Gou which are usually disbursed in three tranches as opposed to recurrent grants. Of the total revenues, recurrent amounted to Ugx: 26,895,000 representing 11% while development revenues amounted to Ugx: 125,248,000 representing 54%. Development revenues over performed at 54% due to receipt of one off funds meant for completion of 4 Classroom block in Obalanga Seed SS. This is further broken down as Other Transfers from Central Government amounting to Ugx: 100,000,000 representing 74%, Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs Gou amounting to Ugx: 25,248,000 representing 33% as expected and External Financing performed at 0% due to delayed receipt of TASO funds. The departments cumulative expenditure stood at Ugx: 23,161,000 that represented 5% of the annual budget. Wage consumed only 19% while Non-Wage further under performed at 3% of the annual budget. Development expenditure on the other hand performed at only 3% of the annual budget. The sub Sub Programme had a total unspent balance amounting to Ugx: 128,982,000 representing 85% of the quarter's out turn. Recurrent balances amounted to Ugx: 9,677,000 representing 36% of the received funds of which Wage of Ugx: 3,855,000 and Non Wage of Ugx: 5,822,000. The total revenues are slightly higher than the expected 25% as a result of development revenues which are remitted in three tranches which is at 33% higher than other revenues that are expected to be remitted at 25%. Recurrent revenues, District Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage) and District Unconditional Grant (Wage) all performed at the expected 25% while Locally Raised revenues and Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_NonWage all performed at 18%. This is attributed to low collection of Locally raised revenues by the district. District Discretionary Development Equalization Grant and Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_Gou performed at 33%(6,923,000/=) and 35%(5,777,000/=) respectively. Workplan Expenditure; The department had a cumulative expenditure of Uganda Shillings: 16,564,000/= which represents 16% of the annual budget. Wage and non-wage expenditure which performed at 9% and 14% respectively. The department's total unspent balances stood at 12,644,000/= representing 43% of the total revenues received/cumulative outturn of which recurrent balances stood at 8,277,000/= representing 50% while domestic development balances stood at 4,367,000/= representing 34%. The wage and non-wage balances are 4,009,000/= and 4,268,000/= respectively.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Wage balance of 4,009,000/= was as a result of delayed recruitment of the District/Senior Planner hence only one person was paid. Non Wage balance of 4,268,000/= was meant for implementation of activities in Q2. Development balance of 4,367,000/= was as a result of low absorption by LLGs.
